### **Board Chair and Chief Executive Officer's Report**

It has been quite a year with many celebrations, challenges, and transitions. The Board of Directors was pleased to announce the appointment of Juanita Lawson as the new CEO in May 2017. Juanita has already made a significant contribution to NorWest as Director of Clinical Services, and the Board is excited to be working with Juanita in her new role as CEO. We feel confident that we are well positioned to navigate upcoming challenges and changes that are occurring in the healthcare system in the region.

Juanita's appointment was preceded by Wendy Talbot's retirement after 20 years with NorWest. The Board of Directors is grateful to Wendy for her leadership and the impact that she had in developing NorWest during her tenure.

We also celebrated the grand opening of the new expanded Thunder Bay site in November 2016. The Board appreciates the hard work of every member of the team in Thunder Bay in making this transition successful and with as little disruption as possible to services.

The Board of Directors is also appreciative of the staff and managers' ongoing commitment to the communities we serve and for delivering services and programs that promote our mission that "Every One Matters". It was gratifying to have this recognized by the community as recipients of the Thunder Bay Chamber of Commerce Not-For-Profit Excellence Award.

We are pleased to report that the capital build at the Thunder Bay site was completed on schedule in October 2016 allowing for an additional 16,500ft<sup>2</sup> of space. Our grand opening and launch of the new NorWest CHC website took place November 2016.

NorWest CHC recognizes that there are many individuals in our community who experience barriers to accessing health and social services and are at higher risk of poor health. NorWest CHC has established effective partnerships with numerous organizations to increase access to health and health promotion services. Safe Talk, Thunder Bay Memory Clinics, enhanced harm reduction services, and ID clinics were all successfully launched this year as a result of these relationships. Expansion of the fetal alcohol spectrum disorder diagnostic clinic, mental health, LGBTQ, seniors, and chronic pain management continue to support individual's health and well-being. The addition of health links staff in Thunder Bay and Longlac support individuals with complex medical and social needs.

In the past year, Thunder Bay saw the arrival of government and privately sponsored Syrian Refugee families. Nor-West CHC in partnership with Thunder Bay Multicultural Association have been actively working to provide primary health and allied health care services.

As an organization, we will continue to effectively engage and work with individuals and communities and advocate for health equity. We could not do this without the dedication of our board, management, staff and volunteers. Thank you for your commitment and ability to make this organization so vibrant and dynamic.
