4ANPP

DRUG CONTAMINANT

.....WHAT IS IT?

It is a precursor to fentanyl. It is used by illicit substance manufacturers to make fentanyl.

CUTTING AGENT IN:

It is found in fentanyl samples or other opioid products when they are not cooked properly. It indicates a poorly made product.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Although it is highly toxic on its own, once in drug product it is not harmful and should not cause side effects.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON 4ANPP?

NOT EXACTLY! However, it is likely present within an opioid product which you can overdose from.

Monitor for overdose signs and call 9-1-1!

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
