

# ACETYLFENTANYL

ANALOG OF FENTANYL: ACETYL FENTANYL

## .....WHAT IS IT?

A synthetic opioid pain reliever similar to fentanyl. It is illegally produced and often sold as a white powder.

## POTENCY:

Less potent than fentanyl however, it is absorbed more quickly so effects will be felt sooner. It is found as a substitute for fentanyl in the local supply.

## WHAT WILL IT DO?

Relieves pain, depresses respiratory system, and causes drowsiness or loss of consciousness.

Can lead to coma or death from lack of oxygen/insufficient breathing.



## CAN I OVERDOSE ON ACETYLFENTANYL?

**YES!** Acetylfentanyl causes opioid overdoses!  
Administer Naloxone and call 9-1-1!

## SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF ACETYLFENTANYL OVERDOSE:

- Pale skin, cold and clammy hands, or blue lips
- No breathing or inadequate breathing & decrease or lack of pulse
- Dizziness, confusion, small pupils, limp body, or difficulties waking up

## TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client, administer Naloxone & Call 911
