

BROMAZOLAM

(ANALOGUE OF ALPRAZOLAM: BENZO CLASS)

.....WHAT IS IT?

It is a triazolo-benzodiazepine (TBZD) that is sold as a designer drug. Sedative effects within the benzo class. Central nervous system depressant.

POTENCY

Similar potency to alprazolam. Seen as a contaminant in presumed fentanyl samples.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Causes drowsiness, euphoria, sedation, and muscle-relaxing effects.

Can cause weakness, confusion, slurred speech, seizures, coma or hallucinations.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON BROMAZOLAM?

YES! It can cause overdoses. Since it is not an opioid, **Naloxone will not work!!** Call 911 and maintain their airway.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF BROMAZOLAM OVERDOSE:

- Prolonged sedation, coma, dizziness, confusion, shallow breathing
- Pale colour, blue lips and extremities

TIPS:

- **Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!**
- **Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App**
- **Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)**



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
