CUTTING AGENT

.....WHAT IS IT?

Cellulose is a type of fibre found in plant foods. It is a polysaccharide and it links to glucose units.

CUTTING AGENT IN:

Found in cocaine, opioids, and other drugs.

It is odorless and has no taste which makes it an easy cutting agent to bulk up street drugs.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

May cause gas, bloating, and increased stool production.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON CELLULOSE?

NOT EXACTLY! You cannot overdose on cellulose, but you could overdose from drugs it is cut into.

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
