

# FLUALPRAZOLAM

BENZODIAZEPINE CLASS

## .....WHAT IS IT?

It is a tranquilizer of the triazolo-benzodiazepine (TBZD) class sold as a designer drug. Has similar sedative effects to benzos.

It is a white powder.

## POTENCY:

Higher potency than alprazolam with a quicker onset due to rapid absorption.

Seen as a contaminant in the opioid street supply.

## WHAT WILL IT DO?

Causes central nervous system depression with sedative and hypnotic effects.

Can cause seizure, weakness, confusion, slurred speech, slowed breathing, coma or hallucinations.



## CAN I OVERDOSE ON FLUALPRAZOLAM?

**YES!** You can overdose on Flualprazolam. It's not an opioid, so **Naloxone will not reverse the overdose!** Call 911 and maintain their airway!

## SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF FLUALPRAZOLAM OVERDOSE:

- Prolonged sedation, dizziness, confusion, difficulty waking up, coma
- Pale colour, blue lips, shallow or inadequate breathing

## TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
