

FLUBROMAZEPAM

BENZODIAZEPINE CLASS

.....WHAT IS IT?

It is a benzodiazepine derivative that has a very quick absorption time. It is long acting and eliminated slowly. It's a central nervous system depressant.

POTENCY:

It has a similar potency to phenazepam.

It has been seen as a contaminant in opioid products.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Causes sedation, euphoria, weakness, confusion, slurred speech, coma and slows breathing.

Can cause adverse heart and psychologic effects.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON FLUBROMAZEPAM?

YES! You can overdose on Flubromazepam. It's not an opioid, so **Naloxone will not reverse the overdose!** Call 911 and maintain their airway!

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF FLUBROMAZEPAM OVERDOSE:

- Prolonged sedation, dizziness, confusion, difficulty waking up, coma
- Pale colour, blue lips, shallow or inadequate breathing

TIPS:

- **Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!**
- **Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App**
- **Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)**



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
