FLUOROFENTANYL

OPIOID CLASS

.....WHAT IS IT?

It is a synthetic analogue of fentanyl. It is an opioid pain reliever.

Usually illegally produced and is often found as a white powder.

POTENCY:

Has similar potency to fentanyl. Since it is illegally produced, potency is not consistent so it could be more potent than fentanyl in some samples.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Decreases alertness, pain, breathing, heart rate, blood pressure, body temp and consciousness.

Can cause euphoria, constipation and coma.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON FLUOROFENTANYL?

YES! Fluorofentanyl can cause severe opioid overdoses! Administer Naloxone and call 911 immediately!

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF FLUOROFENTANYL OVERDOSE:

- Pale/blue skin that could be cold or clammy
- Decreased breathing and/or pulse
- Dizziness, confusion, small pupils, and difficult to wake up

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client, administer Naloxone & Call 911
