HEROIN

(H, SMACK, CHINA WHITE, TINA, SNOW, DOPE)

.....WHAT IS IT?

Heroin is an illegal opioid that is made from morphine, which comes from the opium poppy. It is highly addictive.

POTENCY:

3 x stronger than morphine Less potent than fentanyl

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Decreases alertness, pain, heart rate, body temperature and consciousness. May cause euphoria, sedation, constipation, and may lower or stop breathing.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON HEROIN?

YES! Heroin can easily cause opioid overdoses when overused. It can also cause muscle rigidity or loss of body control!

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF HEROIN OVERDOSE:

- Pale/blue skin that could be cold or clammy
- Decreased breathing and/or pulse
- Dizziness, confusion, small pupils, and difficult to wake up

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client, administer Naloxone & Call 911
