# **HYDROMORPHONE**

OPIOID CLASS

#### .....WHAT IS IT?

It is an opioid pain reliever used to treat moderate to severe pain.

It is also called Dilaudid and referred to as "Dilly" on the street.

## **POTENCY:**

5-10 x stronger than morphine.

Less potent than fentanyl.

## **WHAT WILL IT DO?**

Decreases pain, blood pressure, heart rate, and body temp.

Can cause euphoria, sedation, upset stomach, or constipation.



## **CAN I OVERDOSE ON HYDROMORPHONE?**

YES! Hydromorphone can cause an opioid overdose. Administer Naloxone and call 911 immediately!

### SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF HYDROMORPHONE OVERDOSE:

- Pale/blue skin that could be cold or clammy
- Decreased breathing and/or pulse
- Dizziness, confusion, small pupils, and difficult to wake up

## TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client, administer Naloxone & Call 911
