

KETAMINE

(VITAMIN K, SPECIAL K, KIT KAT, SUPER ACID, K)

.....WHAT IS IT?

It is an NMDA receptor agonist and dissociative anesthetic. Medically used for depression, PTSD, pain management and anesthesia.

POTENCY:

Potency is dependent on route of consumption (oral, inhalation, injection). IV consumption can cause prolonged sedation.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Causes a sense of dissociation from reality, euphoria, and hallucinations.

Can cause intracranial pressure, agitation, high blood pressure, seizure or panic attacks.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON KETAMINE?

YES! You can overdose on Ketamine if a very large amount is taken. **Naloxone will not reverse an overdose!** Call 911 and monitor for chest pain!

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF KETAMINE OVERDOSE:

- Vomiting, confusion, high blood pressure, rapid heart rate
- Chest pain, seizure, paralysis
- Prolonged sedation, irreversible psychologic effects

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
