LISDEXAMFETAMINE

(VYVANSE, ELVANSE)

.....WHAT IS IT?

It is a central nervous system stimulant that is most commonly prescribed to treat ADHD.

POTENCY:

Much less potent than illegal stimulants like cocaine or meth.

This medication is sometimes diverted and sold on the street.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Increases alertness, mood, and heart rate.

Can cause loss of appetite, agitation, blurred vision, headache, nausea, or vomiting.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON LISDEXAMFETAMINE?

YES! Lisdexamfetamine can be overused and can cause a stimulant overdose! This medication should be taken as prescribed only.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF LISDEXAMFETAMINE OVERDOSE:

- Increased heart rate or heartbeat disruptions leading to heart attack or stroke
- Vomiting, nausea, diarrhea, disorientation, or seizure

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
