

# LISDEXAMFETAMINE

(VYVANSE, ELVANSE)

## .....WHAT IS IT?

It is a central nervous system stimulant that is most commonly prescribed to treat ADHD.

## POTENCY:

Much less potent than illegal stimulants like cocaine or meth.

This medication is sometimes diverted and sold on the street.

## WHAT WILL IT DO?

Increases alertness, mood, and heart rate.

Can cause loss of appetite, agitation, blurred vision, headache, nausea, or vomiting.



## CAN I OVERDOSE ON LISDEXAMFETAMINE?

**YES!** Lisdexamfetamine can be overused and can cause a stimulant overdose! This medication should be taken as prescribed only.

## SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF LISDEXAMFETAMINE OVERDOSE:

- Increased heart rate or heartbeat disruptions – leading to heart attack or stroke
- Vomiting, nausea, diarrhea, disorientation, or seizure

## TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
