METHAMPHETAMINE

(METH, JIB, SPEED, CRYSTAL, CRANK, ICE)

.....WHAT IS IT?

Meth is an illegal and highly addictive stimulant drug. It is derived from amphetamine which is used in decongestants and some ADHD medications.

POTENCY:

Meth remains in the body 12 times longer than cocaine.

Potency can vary since it is an illegal and unregulated product.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Increases alertness, breathing, body temp, heart rate, and blood pressure.

Causes dental problems, itching, wounds, decreases appetite, and can alter brain structure!



CAN I OVERDOSE ON METH?

YES! Meth can cause stimulant overdoses. It can also lead to permanent changes to your brain and behaviour!

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF METHAMPHETAMINE OVERDOSE:

- Increased heart rate, body temperature, blood pressure leading to possible heart attack, stroke, or seizure
- Vomiting, nausea, diarrhea, and disorientation

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client & Call 911(administer Naloxone as it may also contain opiates)
