METONITAZENE

OPIOID CLASS

.....WHAT IS IT?

Metonitazene is a synthetic opioid pain reliever that is related to etonitazene and isotonitazene.

It is illegally manufactured.

POTENCY:

It is stronger than hydromorphone and fentanyl.

It has a quick onset which can lead to a rapid overdose.

WHAT WILL IT DO?

Relieves pain, causes euphoria, and drowsiness.

Lowers heart rate, blood pressure and breathing which could lead to coma or death.



CAN I OVERDOSE ON METONITAZENE?

YES! It can cause a severe opioid overdose! Multiple doses of Naloxone may be required! Call 911 immediately!

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF METONITAZENE OVERDOSE:

- Pale/blue skin that could be cold or clammy
- Decreased breathing and/or pulse
- Dizziness, confusion, small pupils, and difficult to wake up

TIPS:

- Get your drugs tested! Start with a small amount!
- Do not use alone, if you are alone you can download the Lifeguard App
- Try to rouse the client, administer Naloxone & Call 911
